The 2nd biennial National Adaptation Forum took place in St. Louis, Missouri on May 12-14, 2015 and was phenomenally successful! Wow, **812** adaptation professionals participated from every state in the United States, the District of Columbia, one territory, three Canadian provinces, and five additional countries. Registrants represented 37% government, 30% non-profit, 15% university research/teaching, 10% student, and 8% corporate. Participants enjoyed 71 symposia, 21 training sessions, 25 working groups, 76 poster presentations, 18 tools in the Tools Café, along with 2 Plenaries and 2 Networking Events.
